The Petersburg Symphony Orchestra (PSO) is a diverse ensemble comprising over 50 volunteer and professional musicians, delighting audiences since its inception in 1978. This initiative, born from the vision of Dr. F. Nathaniel Gatlin, a renowned educator at Virginia State University, has evolved under the guidance of the current Music Director, Naima Burrs.

The PSO is a cherished community asset, showcasing the exceptional talents of musicians from the region and offering a wide array of musical genres. Our commitment lies in preserving, nurturing, educating, and delivering high-quality, diverse music experiences through customized performing arts programs for all age groups. We create music not only for the Tri-Cities region but also for audiences beyond.

The orchestra's inaugural performance, Concert Number One, occurred on Sunday, April 29, 1979, in the auditorium of Petersburg High School. For more than four decades, the PSO has provided a platform for orchestral instrument players, supported young musicians, introduced new compositions to the public, collaborated with fellow musical organizations, and made orchestra music accessible to individuals who might otherwise have missed out on this enriching experience.

LeTriel White

LeTriel Monique White, a full-time music faculty member at Delaware State University, is a versatile musician, excelling as a clarinetist in orchestral and chamber music while also showcasing her talents as a saxophonist and flutist in jazz, alternative rock, R&B, and rap genres. Based in Houston, TX, she has had an impressive performance history for the past decade, sharing the stage with renowned acts like The Temptations, The Joe Sample Jazz Orchestra, The Four Tops, and more. Beyond performing, Ms. White is dedicated to music education, teaching in school districts, serving as a D'Addario Reserve Method Clinician, and contributing to the music department at Texas Southern University. Currently pursuing her Doctorate in Musical Arts at Arizona State University, she's committed to nurturing the next generation of artists.



James Gates


James "Saxsmo" Gates, a prominent musician in Richmond, VA, is known for his passionate saxophone performances that captivate jazz enthusiasts. A Richmond native, he earned his Bachelor of Music degree from Berklee College of Music in 1983 and a Masters in Jazz Studies from North Carolina Central University in 2011. Gates has an extensive history of performing with jazz legends and notable artists, including Joe Kennedy, Jr., Dizzy Gillespie, and Roberta Flack. He is also a dedicated jazz educator, serving as the Founder and Director of the Dr. Billy Taylor Jazz Studies Program at Virginia State University. Alongside his successful music career, Saxsmo has released multiple albums, with his latest, "Stepping Out," released in April 2020.

Desirée Roots

Desirée Roots is a multi-talented performer with over 30 years of acting, singing, and dancing acclaim. She made her stage debut at 13 as Dorothy in "The Wiz" and has since impressed in over 30 productions. Notable roles include Vera Charles in "Mame" and Effie White in "DREAMGIRLS." She's celebrated for her versatile 3 1/2 octave vocal range, performing jazz, gospel, opera, and more, and has shared the stage with music legends like Buddy Guy and BB King. In 2004, she received the Theresa Pollak Prize for Excellence in the Arts for "Best Vocalist in Virginia." She is currently the Artistic Director of Community at Virginia Repertory Theatre.



Weldon Hill

Weldon Hill is a versatile musician known as a professional pianist, composer, arranger, and musicologist. His extensive career has seen him perform alongside jazz luminaries such as Jon Faddis, Joe Williams, and Benny Carter and lead his own piano trio. Hill's contributions to music extend to writing, recording, and scholarly work, with his dissertation on Duke Ellington's Sacred Concerts considered a seminal work in musicology. He holds advanced music degrees and is actively involved in education and leadership roles at institutions like Virginia Union University and Virginia State University, where he has retired as Chair of Virginia State University School of Music.

Anyango Yarbo-Davenport

Anyango Yarbo-Davenport, a Munich, Germany native, is a distinguished violinist with a rich musical heritage. She has graced renowned venues like Carnegie Hall and the Kennedy Center, showcasing her talent across the Americas, Europe, and Asia. Anyango's debut CD, "AMERICANA!" (2022), features contemporary American music and received acclaim. As an accomplished soloist and conductor, she leads the Colour of Music Festival Virtuosi, championing diversity in classical music. With a Doctoral degree from the Eastman School of Music, she's also a devoted educator and professor, nurturing the next generation of musicians while researching musician health and promoting underrepresented composers. Anyango's artistry is matched by her dedication to teaching and performance excellence. She plays an 18th-century French violin and collaborates with artists worldwide.

Christoph Wagner

Dr. Christoph Wagner is an accomplished cellist and dedicated educator on a mission to impact the world through music. He's earned numerous accolades, including first prizes in prestigious competitions and scholarships from organizations like the Richard Wagner Verband and the Lions Club. Wagner has graced renowned concert halls across Europe and four continents, collaborating with esteemed conductors and performing at festivals worldwide. Beyond his virtuoso performances, he's a passionate music ambassador, engaging in community outreach and research on musician injuries. He holds advanced music degrees, was an adjunct faculty member at Lone Star College in Houston, TX, from 2018–2023, recently started a position as Assistant Professor of Music at the University of New Mexico, and is a respected masterclass and lecture provider in the United States and South America.

Joanne Kong

Joanne Kong, a groundbreaking keyboardist, captivates audiences with her vibrant and eloquent musical performances. She is the first artist to release a harpsichord-piano recording of Bach's Goldberg and Beethoven's Diabelli Variations. Additionally, she premiered Michael Colgrass's Pulitzer Prizewinning concerto "Side by Side," a unique work for a soloist performing as both pianist and harpsichordist. Kong's expertise extends to teaching master classes in keyboard and chamber performance and workshops on Performance Anxiety and Effective Practicing Techniques worldwide. Her illustrious career has earned her national and international honors, including fellowships from the American Academy of the Arts in Europe and the Bach Aria Festival, and top prizes in prestigious competitions. She is currently the Director of Accompaniment and Coordinator of Chamber Music Ensembles at the University of Richmond.
